

Request for site specific biodiversity condition, under condition 21 of the Coastal Integrated Forestry Operations Approval

Under condition 31.3 of 'Protocol 31: Matters covered by the approval' (made on 19 September 2023), the EPA may specify the information Forestry Corporation of NSW must provide when requesting a *site-specific biodiversity condition* to inform its consultation and development.

The form below applies to any request for a *site-specific biodiversity condition* as required by condition 21 of the *approval* for any record of Koala (in *koala hubs* in the *Provisional GKNP assessment area*). This form replaces any other information required under condition 31.3(1)(b) of 'Protocol 31: Matters covered by the approval' (made on 19 September 2023).
