Agenda Item 1 - Welcome

Greg Piper, Chair (GP) welcomed all to the meeting and thanked everyone for attending.

Agenda Item 2 – Apologies

Agenda Item 3 – Minutes from Previous Meeting

The Minutes from the previous meeting were adopted unanimously.

Agenda Item 4 – Repository (including request by Boolaroo Action Group (BAG) to open Boolaroo Facility)

GP tabled the request by the BAG to open a repository in North Lake Macquarie.

Motion:

 That the LMLCRG express to the EPA appreciation for the efforts of the EPA, Lake Macquarie City Council (LMCC) and Newcastle City Council (NCC) to establish an agreement for a lead contaminated soil repository at Summerhill.

Meeting No. 21 18 December 2017

- Expresses concern that subsequent requirements for the use of "bulka bags" to deliver material to Summerhill under the arrangements will diminish the utility of the site for this purpose and may exacerbate risks that materials are disposed of when opportunity arises (redevelopment) or see material disposed of illegally.
- Requests that the EPA seek to have the "bulka bag" limitation imposed by NCC removed. 3.
- Requests, that if a resolution to the restrictions placed on the use of Summerhill as a repository is not found within 3 months, the EPA and LMCC seek to develop a repository within the LMCC LGA.

Agenda Item 5 – Further Funding

GP advised the CRG that he would draft a motion for further funding.

Motion:

That the Lead Community Reference Group advises the Minister for the Environment that while the recent announcement of \$23.5 million for management of contamination issues in NSW is appreciated, it believes that the portion allocated to northern Lake Macquarie and the four year funding term is likely to be inadequate and therefore requests that the amount and duration of the allocation be reconsidered to allow for an increase in amount and of the duration of the program.

AG committed to ongoing 6 monthly reporting to CRG members on the LEWG progress in consultation with LMCC.
