

Radiation Guideline 2

Preparation of radiation management plans

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Introduction

This guideline provides the responsible person (licensee) with a list of the information required in a radiation management plan in order to comply with the requirements of the NSW Environment Protection Authority (EPA). Some items listed below will not be applicable to all organisations using regulated material.

This guideline should be read in conjunction with the *Radiation Control Act 1990* (the Act), the *Radiation Control Regulation 2013* (the Regulation), and relevant conditions of licence and/or accreditation.

The radiation management plan once prepared, must be available for inspection and review by the NSW EPA.

The responsible person may adopt this guideline or use a radiation management plan from the [Australian Radiation Protection and Nuclear Safety Agency](#) (ARPANSA) codes and guidelines, but it will be necessary to state whether the 'adopted' document is to be applied in whole or in part and, if the latter, which particular parts apply.
